Study by yourself

S.O.A.P. Bible Study Method

S - Scripture

Watch the video, if there is one, and read the Bible passage

O - Observation

What stands out to you? What’s surprising? What are the key themes, promises, or challenges? What might the people be thinking? How might they be feeling?

A - Application

How does it apply to your life? What would you do to respond? What changes might you make?

P - Prayer

Thank God for what you’ve learned and ask for His help to apply it.

Study with others

Don’t forget to eat together 😊

Early questions

1. Something positive in your life (currently)?
2. Something difficult in your life?
3. Other recent news, thoughts or events from your life to share?
4. What is God saying to you in those?

Later questions

1. How did you go with actions out of last meeting, if any?
2. What stood out in your recent daily devotions - about you and/or about God?
3. What stood out in the recent sermon - about you and/or about God?
4. How might God call you to respond? What would God have you do about it?
